COVID-19 – PLANNING DOCUMENT

Updated: January 3, 2022

THE GUIDELINES BELOW WERE DEVELOPED BASED ON WHAT IS CURRENTLY KNOWN ABOUT THE TRANSMISSION AND SEVERITY OF COVID-19 AND COVID-19 VARIANTS AND ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

The following rules apply to all NYSBC staff:			
Vaccination	All staff members are required to be fully vaccinated. ¹ You will be considered fully vaccinated 7 days after receiving a booster shot.		
Upon Entering NYSBC	All staff and visitors must show proof of vaccination to enter the facility A copy of your proof of vaccination (e.g., CDC card, NYS Excelsior Pass) should be sent to Arjun Koshal		
Masks	KN95 or N95 masks are to be worn in the Center unless you are alone in your lab or office		
Distancing	You should stay at least six feet apart from other people indoors You can gather or conduct activities outdoors without staying six feet apart from other fully vaccinated people		
COVID-19 Symptoms	Even if you have been vaccinated, DO NOT come to the Center if you have any of the following symptoms: Cough Repeated shaking with chills Fever Chills New loss of taste or smell Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing Muscle pain Headache Sore throat

¹ Reasonable accommodations will be made for staff who refuse vaccination due to pregnancy, disability or sincerely held religious belief or practice.

Protocol for Exposure to COVID-19	If you have received your booster shot at least seven days ago and are asymptomatic, you may return to the Center after close contact ² with someone who had COVID-19. However, you must get tested 5 to 7 days after your close contact with a rapid antigen test, even if you do not have symptoms. If you have not received your booster shot at least seven days ago and are asymptomatic, you can use a negative rapid antigen test result collected on Day 5 after close contact and return to the Center on Day 7, with additional self-monitoring. The day of exposure is considered day zero. Notify your supervisor and Arjun Koshal of any close contact with someone who had COVID-19.
Protocol for COVID-19 Symptoms and/or Positive Test	If you think or know you have COVID-19, and you have symptoms, you can only return to the Center after: • 10 days since symptoms first appeared, • 24 hours with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medications, and • other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving.³ If you test positive and have no symptoms, you can return to the Center after 10 days have passed since you had a positive test (based on the date you were tested). If you develop symptoms after testing positive, your 10-day isolation period must start over, and you must follow the guidance above under "Protocol for Exposure to COVID-19". Notify your supervisor and Arjun Koshal have COVID-19 symptoms or have tested positive for COVID-19.
Transportation	If you travel by public transportation, taxi or car service, wear a KN95 or N95 mask and, to the extent possible, stay at least six feet from other people.
Travel	 New York State no longer requires asymptomatic travelers from another state to test or quarantine. All international travelers must: Monitor symptoms for 14 days after arriving in New York Continue to wear a mask; and Immediately self-isolate if any symptoms develop and contact the local public health authority or your healthcare provider to determine if you should get tested Fully vaccinated international travelers arriving in the United States are still required to get tested within 3 days of their flight and should still get tested 3-5 days after their trip.

² "Close contact" occurs when an individual was within 6 feet of someone for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period.

³ Loss of taste and smell may persist for weeks or months after recovery and need not delay the end of isolation.

The following rules apply to affiliates, visitors, and contractors:		
COVID-19 Symptoms	Affiliates, visitors, and contractors must be vaccinated to enter the facility and are not permitted onsite if they have any COVID-19 symptoms.	
Masks	Affiliates, visitors, and contractors must wear a KN95 or N95 mask while onsite. A KN95 or N95 mask will be provided by NYSBC if necessary.	
Distancing	To the extent practicable, affiliates, visitors, and contractors should stay at least six feet away from staff members.	

General:		
Bathrooms	Use sanitizing wipes to wipe down bathroom before and after use. Do <u>not</u> flush sanitizing wipes; use the waste basket	
Hygiene	Use hand sanitizer upon entering the Center	
	Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds	
	Use hand sanitizers and wipes after touching common surfaces; throw out wipes right after use	
	Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth	
	Cough or sneeze into elbow or tissue (to be disposed of immediately)	
	No handshaking	
	Clean work areas before and after work (or more frequently) with 70% isopropyl alcohol
